"European research stakeholders have been intensifying the preparatory works on the implementation of the European Open Science Cloud (EOSC) initiative, being closely followed by the EU Member States' Governments. The 'Big Picture' of the development of the Czech national data infrastructure, presented in September 2021, is a key milestone on the way to implement EOSC in the Czech Republic. The Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports has already allocated over EUR 100 mil. of investments to trigger the hardware acquisition, boost the software development and bring up the data management specialists. All in all, a solid kick-off to make the Czech scientific data FAIR (Findable, Accessible, Interoperable and Reusable) inter-nationally."
